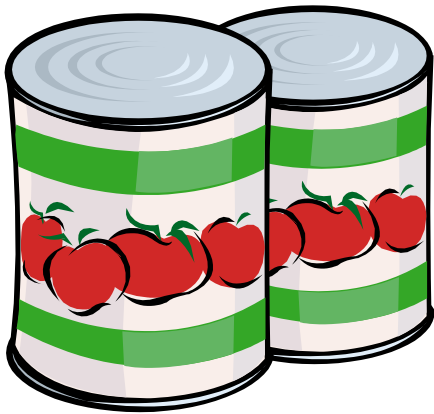
### **I CARE Club Update...**
