Principal's Notes

Traffic- We have new families that enroll students throughout the year. Sometimes they are not familiar with our traffic pattern and rules. Please remember to stay in your car unless you are parked next to the grassy island. Keep pulling up closer to building whenever possible, this allows us to get as many cars into the parking lot and off of 144th street as possible. The goal is to keep the flow moving, keep in mind however that we are limited by the amount of traffic on 144th. Usually if the line is not moving it is because the line is backed up and waiting to pull back onto 144th. **Please continue to be patient and watch for child.**

Crosswalk- I will continue to monitor the crosswalk in the parking lot all winter. However, when the wind chill gets to a certain point I will need to reenter the building to warm up. When possible please use the main drive and unload next to the building eliminating the need to use the crosswalk.

Snow Pants Clarification- Student was welcome to wear snow pants to and from school. As stated in last weeks newsletter we will not be using them during recess. During recess students are not allowed to roll around in the snow and we typically stay inside when the temperature is cold enough to need snow pants for warmth.
